



ASIS PAP Standard – How can **Citicus ONE** help?

<p>The PAP standard recognizes the importance of a risk oriented approach that takes into account the value of assets at risk, the risk appetite of the organization and the need to drive down the likelihood and impact of disruptive incidents affecting physical assets.</p>	<p>Citicus ONE provides capabilities for you to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify the potential and actual impact of incidents in a quantified, objective and consistent manner using an intuitive Harm Reference Table • Compare current risk status with the level you have defined as acceptable • Track actual incidents as a means of monitoring threat levels and the likelihood of suffering major incidents in the future.
<p>The standard provides an Annex of specific controls for physical asset protection that can be used in conjunction with the <i>ASIS Protection of Assets Manual, Facilities Physical Security Measures Guideline</i> and other standards of security controls.</p>	<p>Citicus ONE is supplied out-of-the-box with a library of over 500 controls, drawn from many sources, for the protection of physical assets. These can be easily augmented or replaced by an organization's own security standards, those from standards bodies such as ASIS or external regulatory and legislative requirements.</p>
<p>The standard promotes a cross-discipline and cross-functional risk assessment and management framework that identifies, analyses, evaluates and treats all security risks within a singular, managed process.</p>	<p>Citicus ONE's ability to provide a platform for managing risks to physical assets, information systems and other entities that these depend on makes it a strong solution for achieving the goals for converged security management.</p>
